GWI/ESRB/MBI meeting 3/23/2023

Notes

- JD opened with the status of ESRB and their interest in the BUD model and the committee has committed funds to establishing an interlocal agreement
- Sean (GWI) asked if the committee was set on the BUD model. Bill (ESRB) answered ESRB is interested but not decided. He stated they are down to two models, the BUD being preferred.

- Bill asked if MCA would look favorably on a BUD. Kerem (GWI) stated he believes the MCA would be especially interested in seeding BUDs
- Regarding BEAD Kerem mentioned it's still a bit murky as far as MCA understanding the regulations/requirements for that funding and there are two hurdles that he sees
 - o A letter of credit is one requirement for the entity receiving the funds
 - There is language where the Feds have a lien on the entity and their assets but that there are multiple ways to fund a BUD. There's not one concrete single path where grants and bonds are concerned
- It was stated (or restated) that the MCA is <u>only</u> interested in unserved. Nothing else gets considered
- The question was asked if GWI is interested in investing in the BUD. Kerem's answer was "Maybe...depending on the approach"
- Bill stated one denial reason from the MCA in the last grant round was the applicant would be better served with line extensions
- Line extensions awards will be announced by the MCA 3/24 and again in June timeframe
- GWI if they build West Paris that would make building/serving Sweden easier
- GWI was amenable to an Own and Operate model where they submit the grant application
- Question as to whether MCA will shift funds from "Middle Mile" to "Reach Me" based on the "Reach Me" demand (undetermined)
- Kerem stated that an announcement that GWI and ESRB have agreed to work together would be looked on favorably by the MCA as MCA is looking to ensure town by-in
- Tom (ESRB) asked if they still should move forward with the interlocal agreements if GWI applies
 for the grant. Kerem advised to continue with the interlocal agreement as it provides ESRB
 options
- BUD would be two phased regarding funding. Four unserved towns first with grant assistance. Three remaining towns would require bond

Take aways

- GWI will look closer at Owner/Operator model and provide that information to ESRB
- GWI to rework BUD proposal numbers based on today's meeting
 - *Noted that GWI asked for time to provide the deliverables. MBI will do a check in with GWI by end of next week
